

Worth-Pinkham Memorial Library Minutes
Special Meeting
July 1, 2020
10:00AM

Meeting called to order at 10:08. In attendance is John Mongelli, Gretchen Kaser-Corsillo, Herman Crowley, Hugh Turk, Caroline Richards, Leann Surz, Patricia Crossley. Diane Mardy, Jeff Clutterbuck and Dane PolICASTRO are not in attendance.

General Updates:

- Curbside delivery has begun at the library. Week one was very successful - people were dropping off and picking up. This week has been slower.
- We are able to open tomorrow. No libraries have reported opening tomorrow because of holiday. Some considering a Monday start. HHK is ready to go, but waiting on boro for fire code number so we can determine how many people are allowed in the building at once so the max number of people in at a time can be calculated. G.K. is anticipating a 7/13 date. GK is anticipating a “browsing only” opening.

Temporary Code of Conduct:

- Mask policy will be updated: Masks will be mandatory - must cover both nose and mouth. Patrons who do not comply will be asked to leave.
- Computer use - there will be disposable sleeves over the keyboards and mouse. Computer use may not be available upon first opening. That may come later.
- Unsupervised children age is up from 7 to 14.
- There was discussion about senior/vulnerable population hours. At the beginning of the day, the building is at its cleanest. This doesn't need to be in code of conduct, but can be more of a procedure issue.
- Curbside will remain.
- A copy of the code of conduct will be circulated. G.K. hoping to put something at the bottom of the stairs as well.
- Hugh Turk made a motion to approve the temporary code of conduct and Herman Crowley seconded it. All in favor. This will go into effect July 1, 2020.

New Business:

- The state has reviewed our application and has one question on which they would like clarification; it surrounded cost and G.K. addressed. G.K. unclear as to time table, but we are still being considered.
