



Temporary Additions to Library Code of Conduct

1. Masks must be worn by library patrons over the age of 2 at all times and must completely cover one's nose and mouth. Any patron who does not wear a mask while in the library will be asked to leave. Hands, shirts, and other items of clothing are not acceptable face coverings. Patrons who are medically unable to wear a face covering will be asked to utilize the library's curbside pickup service.
2. Occupancy limits will be instituted based on current guidance from the State of New Jersey and shall be posted at the front entrance. When the limit is reached, incoming patrons will be asked to wait outside and shall be admitted on a first come, first served basis.
3. Patrons must practice social distancing and remain a minimum of six (6) feet apart from other patrons and library employees at all times. All patrons should follow floor signage indicating proper spacing and aisle directions.
4. Patrons shall limit their time in the library to no more than one (1) hour.
5. Public computer sessions shall be limited to thirty (30) minutes.
6. All patrons under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver who shall supervise the duration of their time in the library.
7. Outside furniture may not be brought into the library. For safety reasons, no patron shall sit on the floor.
